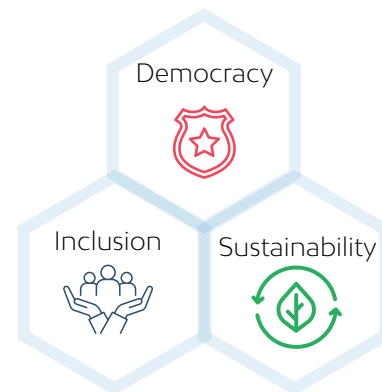

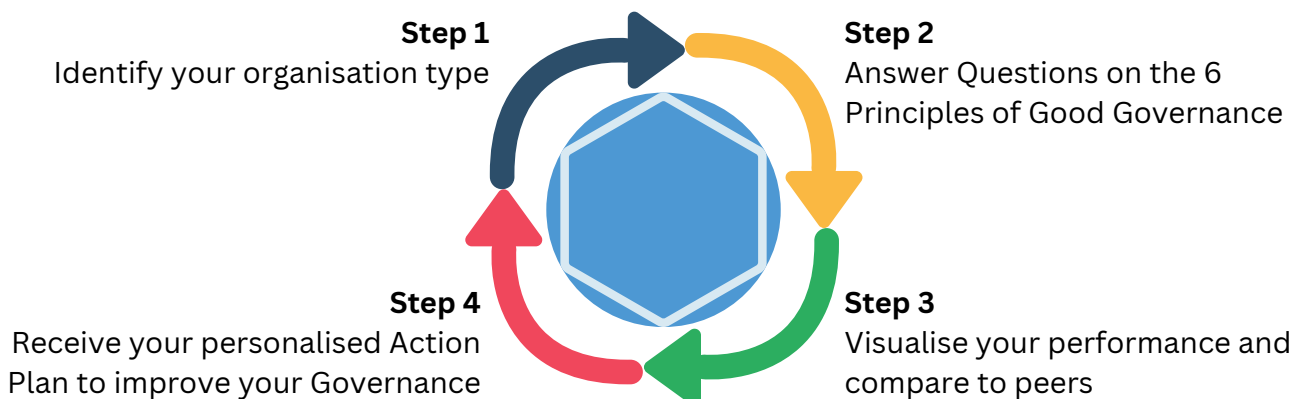
Self-evaluate your Good Governance
